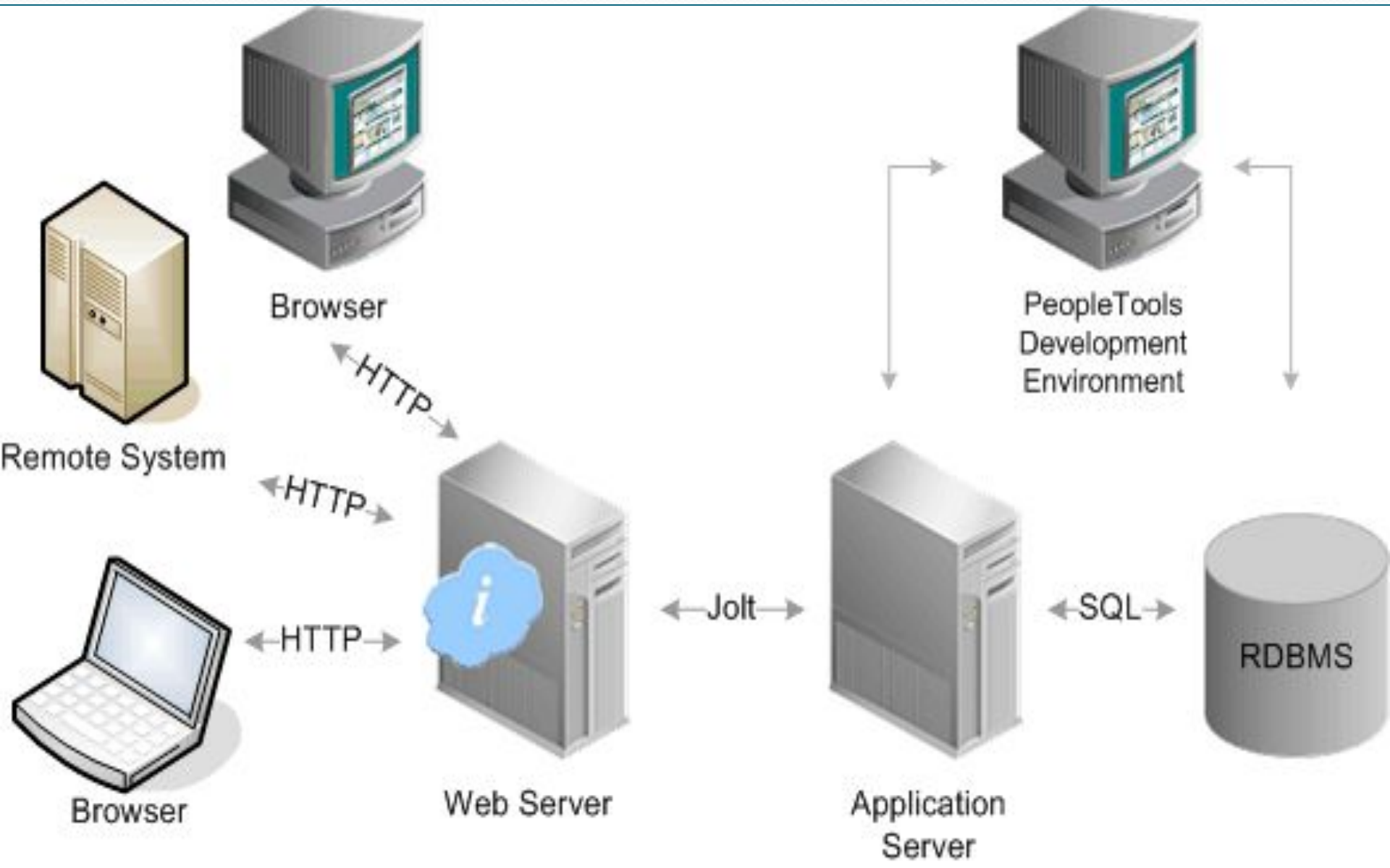
# PeopleSoft - Quick Introduction

- FMS + SCM == FSCM
- Software for Manufacturing, Student Administration to  
large Corporation, Govt. & Organizations
- Acquired by Oracle Corporation in 2005

# PSFT Modules

- 2006: PeopleSoft FSCM 9.0 is released. (Sept 2006)
- 2006: PeopleSoft HCM 9.0 is released. (Dec 2006)
- 2009: PeopleSoft HCM 9.1 is released. (Oct 2009)
- 2009: PeopleSoft FSCM 9.1 is released. (Nov 2009)
- 2013: PeopleSoft 9.2 is released. (FSCM and HCM released simultaneously)
- 2015 PeopleSoft Campus Solutions 9.2 is released (December 2015)

- Develop interfaces, understand table structures, run month-end PSFT batches and generate reports.
- Maintain technical documentation.
- Provide production support for PSFT applications.
- Analyze and resolve problem tickets in a timely manner.
- Provide support in UAT and bug fixing activities.
